trichomoniasis:

also called “trich,” is a very common sexually transmitted disease caused by a parasite.

TRICHOMONIASIS

Trichomoniasis or “trich” is the most common sexually transmitted disease (STD) that can be cured.

HOW DO I GET IT?

A person with trichomoniasis can pass it to their partner during sex without a condom. Men and women can get trich and spread it to others.

HOW CAN I TELL?

Most people with trichomoniasis don't have signs, can't tell and may not know.

Men may feel itching inside the penis. They may feel pain after urinating or ejaculating.

Women may feel pain or itching in the vaginal area. They may feel pain while urinating or having sex, or notice unusual discharge and smell.

You must get tested to know you have trich.

HOW DO I TEST FOR IT?

You can get tested by giving a urine sample or swabbing of the penis, vagina, or anus. You must ask your health care provider to test for trichomoniasis when asking for a STD test.

IS THERE A CURE?

Trichomoniasis is easy to cure with antibiotics from your health care provider. Having trich makes easier for your body to get sick with other STDs. Women who are pregnant and have trich are more likely to deliver early and give birth to low-weight babies. *Learn more and order a free at-home STD test at:*
